

## 2022 UC DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY SURVEY

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY OF RESULTS

The 2022 UC Department of Public Safety Survey was conducted by the University of Cincinnati Institute for Policy Research (IPR). The survey was designed to measure attitudes and opinions of users of Department of Public Safety services.

The survey questionnaire was created in partnership with UC Department of Public Safety staff. An email list used to send survey invitations was provided by the Department of Public Safety. This list included 2,231 individuals (students, faculty and staff) identified as users of public safety services since 2020. These individuals were sent an invitation to participate in a web survey and reminder emails between November 2, 2022 and November 28, 2022. A total of one hundred and seventy-eight (178) individuals responded to the survey. Seventy-seven percent (77%) of respondents were students, while 23 percent faculty or staff. Some caution should be used in interpreting the results of the survey due to the low number of respondents relative to the user population provided by UC Department of Public Safety.

Some of the key findings of the survey include:

#### **Overall Ratings: UC Department of Public Safety Services and Performance of UC Police**

- Sixty-six percent (66%) of survey respondents rate the services provided by the UC Department of Public Safety as “Excellent” (23%) or “Good” (43%). An additional 24 percent of respondents rate the services provided as “Fair” and ten percent (10%) rated them as “Poor”.
  - ✓ Men (34%) and respondents 25 years of age and older (38%) are among those who rate Department of Public Safety services as “Excellent” more frequently than other demographic subgroups.
- Sixty-six percent (66%) of survey respondents also rate the performance of the UC Police as “Excellent” (26%) or “Good” (39%). An additional 24 percent of respondents rate the performance of the police as “Fair” and 11 percent rated them as “Poor”.
  - ✓ Men (37%) and respondents 25 years of age and older (40%) are among those who rate the performance of the UC Police as “Excellent” more frequently than other demographic subgroups.

## **Experiences with UC Department of Public Safety Dispatch and UC Police**

- About 6 of 10 (59%) survey respondents report having contacted UC Department of Public Safety Dispatch during the past two years. Respondents reporting contact were then asked to rate their experiences with Public Safety Dispatch:
  - ✓ Seventy-four percent (74%) “agree” (either “strongly” or “somewhat”) with the statement “The Public Safety Dispatcher was knowledgeable”;
  - ✓ Seventy-one percent (71%) “agree” with the statement “The Public Safety Dispatcher was courteous”; and
  - ✓ Sixty-seven percent (67%) “agree” with the statement “The Public Safety Dispatcher met my expectations in performing their duties”.
- Just over 7 of 10 (72%) survey respondents report having a face-to-face interaction with a UC Police Officer during the past two years. Respondents reporting an interaction were then asked to rate their experiences with UC Police:
  - ✓ Seventy-six percent (76%) “agree” (either “strongly” or “somewhat”) with the statement “The UC Police Officer was knowledgeable”;
  - ✓ Seventy-four percent (74%) “agree” with the statement “The UC Police Officer was courteous”;
  - ✓ Sixty-nine percent (69%) “agree” with the statement “The UC Police Officer met my expectations in performing their duties”; however
  - ✓ Notably fewer (36%) “agree” with the statement “The UCPD Officer followed up with additional information about our interaction at a later date”.

## **Communication from UC Department of Public Safety**

- Survey respondents were asked a series of questions about information they receive from the UC Department of Public Safety. When asked to rate the performance of the UC Department of Public Safety in “keeping the UC community apprised of campus safety related news and events”, 34 percent rate the Department as “excellent”, 36 percent say “good”, 16 percent say “fair” and 14 percent say “poor”. Respondents also rated specific aspects of the information they receive:
  - ✓ Sixty-two percent (62%) rate “communications about ways I can keep myself safe on campus” as “helpful” (either “very” or “somewhat” helpful);
  - ✓ Fifty-two percent (52%) rate “communications about ways I can keep myself safe in the nearby area surrounding campus” as “helpful” (either “very” or “somewhat” helpful).
- Overall, a majority of respondents (59%) say they receive “about the right amount of information about safety” from the UC Department of Public Safety. An additional 36 percent say they receive “too little” information while just six percent (6%) say they receive “too much” information.

## **Perception of Crime On and Off Campus**

Survey respondents were asked a series of questions about crime both on and off campus.

- When asked about the safety on campus during the day and evening:
  - ✓ Eighty-nine percent (89%) “agree” (either “strongly” or “somewhat”) with the statement “The campus is a safe place during the day”; while
  - ✓ Far fewer (44%) “agree” with the statement “The campus is a safe place at night”.
- Survey respondents were also asked whether serious crime has “decreased, increased or stayed about the same” on campus since 2021. Fifty-five percent (55%) say serious crime has “stayed about the same”. An additional 25 percent say serious crime has “increased”, while 20 percent say crime has “decreased”.
  - ✓ While a plurality of women (47%) say crime has “stayed about the same” on campus since 2021, women (36%) say serious crime has increased on campus more frequently than members of any other demographic subgroup.
- When asked about the safety of the nearby area surrounding campus during the day and evening:
  - ✓ Sixty percent (60%) “agree” (either “strongly” or “somewhat”) with the statement “The nearby area surround campus is a safe place during the day”; while
  - ✓ Far fewer (21%) “agree” with the statement “The nearby area surrounding campus is a safe place at night”.
- Survey respondents were also asked whether serious crime has “decreased, increased or stayed about the same” in the nearby area surrounding campus since 2021. Forty-eight percent (48%) say crime has “stayed about the same” and 43 percent say crime has “increased” off campus since 2021. An additional 10 percent say crime has “decreased”.
  - ✓ Respondents 18 to 24 years old (49%) say serious crime has “increased” off campus since 2021 more frequently than older respondents (30%).
  - ✓ Women respondents (47%) say serious crime has “increased” off campus since 2021 more frequently than men (35%).
